Finance - Following the resignation of the Clerk, we are awaiting the return of the documents in this respect – no transactions have taken place since the last meeting.

Highways -

An application has been submitted to the Oxford County Council for a 7.5 ton weight limit for vehicles travelling through the village, this will not apply to access only.

A cycle path between the Nursing Home and the Stratton Audley turn on the A4421 has been suggested. Oxford County Council is investigating finance options via development funding. Big Society funding may be available and research in this respect will be carried out.

Snow Plan –Oxford County Council are to provide us with information regarding giving farmers the ability to clear roads in the village in bad weather, without fear of legal repercussions.

20 mph speed limit in the village – Oxford County Council are investigating the possibility of placing speed monitoring equipment in the village in order to understand with a degree of accuracy whether speeding is an issue the village. If this exercise is carried out, then the results will be considered by the Council and a consultation process started with villagers.

Parish Plan - This has some inaccuracies which the council are attempting to resolve.

Village Facilities - No actions required

AOB - Malachy O'Neil proposed a donation of £100.00 towards the Remembrance wreath, seconded by M Woodward

MW requested £50.00 towards daffodil bulbs
