Significant Year on Year Variances Total other receipts

This was greater than last year primarily because of the receipt of a grant from the Oxfordshire Rural Community Council of £1,000 for the purchase of a marquee for the use of the village and support of the CLP Group. The New Homes Bonus of £2,874 awarded by Cherwell District Council was £364 more and the Community Led Plan group generated fundraising of £209.79. The VAT refund was less by £482.60 this year than last.

Other Costs

Training

More training courses were attended than last year. Previous year spent £162, this year was £212.

Grass Cutting is less than last year following a review of the grass cutting and the engagement of a new contractor. The reduction in costs amounted to £207.50.

Dog bin emptying is less than last year, by £87, because the Spring 15 Bill was sent in April 15 not March so only one payment (of £174.34) was made.

Bulbs. No expenditure was made this year, but the previous year, £40 had been spent.

Highways General Works expenditure was reduced by £150 because the work budgeted for was not completed in the financial year.

Noticeboard The previous year £180 was spent in the noticeboard budget, but nothing was spent this year.

Dog Bin A new dog bin was purchased for £149 the previous year, but nothing was spent this year.

Audit increased by £50 following an increase in charges for the internal audit.

Subscriptions were a great deal less than last year because the only subscription paid in the financial year was the Oxfordshire Playing Fields Association subscription of £40 (an additional subscription) all the rest of the subscriptions have had to be carried over to 2015/16. The previous year's subscriptions totalled £233.

Community Led Plan Following the creation of the Community Led Plan group and the receipt of the grant from ORCC (see receipts), the Parish Council agreed to spend \pounds 1,021, including VAT, on a Marquee. The additional expenses were for the running of the group and the production of a questionnaire. The total expenditure (including the Marquee) was \pounds 2,060; the previous year \pounds 207 had been spent.

Christmas Tree cost less this year as the Parish Council agreed to purchase just one set of lights at £50. This was a reduction of £25.

Election Expenses. The Parish had an uncontested election during the year which cost £39.

Meeting Room Hire. The Parish Council was unable to meet in its usual room for a large proportion of the year and the cost of the room hire increased from £30 to £240.

Fixed Assets

The Marquee (£1,021) and the additional Christmas Lights (£50) were added to the Register and two old items which were no longer used were removed. The Fixed Assets now amount to £39,717.

Parish Reserves

Following the renewal of a Parish Reserves policy in March 2015, the Parish reserved funds for specific purposes stand at:
