Thames Water drain survey

An update is expected by the next meeting.

Resurfacing of Launton Road

Following the September postponement of the repairs into next year due to funding issues, OCC have advised the road does not qualify for consideration under capital expenditure plans which would have allowed for more extensive work. Furthermore it now has to be resubmitted for approval as one of a number of plans that were cut this year.

OCC have offered to meet on site to re-examine requirements and a meeting has been arranged for 19th November.

However in the meantime a resident has pointed out that the road markings by the church need refreshing and are dangerous in their current condition and this is being looked at separately.

The Quarry/Bicester Heritage

A meeting between Parish Council representatives and Bicester Motion is planned for 17th November.

E/W Rail

Passing Points by Stratton Audley Park have now been agreed and residents have been reassured that no trees or tree branches in the avenue will be cut. The road will be closed for 2 weeks from 9th November 2020. Other roads leading to Launton and Marsh Gibbon will also be closed leading up to Christmas.

Corona virus update

Cllr Corkin reminded councillor that the main aim of the lockdown was to reduce person to person contact. More shops (including garden centres and DIY stores) will remain open this time.

37. Church Clock

The Parish Council noted that three companies had submitted quotes for the repair of the clock, the first two were both in excess of £10k but the third estimate was for £1800. In addition a favourable quote for scaffolding had been received of £600. Cllr Corkin agreed to consider an application to his community leader's fund for the cost of the work minus the scaffolding and on this basis the Council gave approval. It was further agreed that the scaffolding cost would be taken out of the Village Improvement fund.

38. Remembrance Sunday

Commemoration of Remembrance Sunday will take place in the Church yard at 9.30am, on a socially distanced basis. The ceremony has spaces for 30 people, additional participants will be welcome to stand in the road or pavement.

39. Christmas tree

The Clerk was asked to order one Christmas tree for the village.

40. Village road sweep.

This will take place on 30th November.

41. Post Office facilities

The Clerk was contacted recently with a suggestion of the provision of 1 hour a week Post Office facilities in the village. The council agreed that it supported the suggestion, and the clerk was asked to pursue this.

42. Stoke Lyne road housing

Residents have expressed concern at proposals to alter plans for plot 3 to increase the number of bedrooms and exterior appearance of the property. The developer has so far not presented any revised plans. The issue has been reported to CDC and Cllr Corkin agreed to make enquiries.
